Laleham Roadworks Update

For the first time in a very long while, it has been possible to drive through Laleham without delays from roadworks. The new roundabout, in use since August, has already caused some confusion, particularly for drivers approaching from Shepperton who attempt to take it the wrong way round. Almost as soon as it was completed, a lorry also discovered that the raised central kerb was more of a challenge than expected! The zebra crossing by the village stores has quickly become a notable feature.

Looking ahead, Surrey Highways' Roadworks Map shows that major resurfacing and reconstruction are due to begin soon on both Ashford Road and Staines Road. The LRA will continue to monitor this closely.

In addition, new white gates have been installed at the village entrances, replacing the colourful "*Welcome to Laleham*" signs. We have recovered and safely stored the metal signs. We welcome residents' views on where they should be reinstalled.

Planning Application: Shepperton Quarry, Littleton Lane

This large 55-hectare site has been the subject of a long-term restoration plan, designed to return the land for public use with landscaping and pedestrian access from Laleham Park. However, Brett Aggregates (the owner) has now applied to extend the restoration deadline indefinitely. Despite being on Surrey County Council's consultation list, the LRA was only recently made aware of this proposal. We are now

seeking clarification from SCC on the latest plans.
