

Laleham Roadworks

Roadworks continue around Laleham, including ongoing disruption on the Broadway footpath and new speed cushions on Staines Road - still without the expected 20mph limit. Surrey Highways has also begun major footway reconstruction on Ashford Road, as detailed in the hand-delivered letter dated 15th October. The works started on 2nd November and are scheduled to run for around 11 to 13 weeks, with Surrey County Council listing the official dates as 4th November 2025 to 16th January 2026. Temporary traffic lights will operate throughout, and residents are asked not to park between Pineacre and Grange Place to keep the area clear for the teams on site.
