

Laleham Residents Association Update: Community Events, Local Issues and Village News

There is much to look forward to in Laleham over the coming months, with a strong programme of community events offering plenty of opportunities for residents to get involved. Whether you would enjoy opening your garden, volunteering at the Village Fair, exploring local history or simply keeping up to date with village news, there are many ways to take part in community life. The Laleham Residents Association (LRA) continues to keep residents informed through its Town Cry emails, website and community updates.

LRA Annual General Meeting 20th May

The LRA's Annual General Meeting will take place on Wednesday 20th May 2026 at 7.30pm at the Lucan Pavilion. The AGM provides an opportunity for members to hear updates on village matters and question the committee about its work over the past year. Local councillors are expected to attend, giving residents the chance to raise issues directly with their elected representatives. Membership renewals will also be available on the evening, and the pavilion bar will be open.

Open Gardens Day 6th June

The much-loved Laleham Gardens Open Day returns on Saturday 6 June, from 10am to 3pm. Held in memory of the late Beryl Shattock, whose dedication helped make the event a village favourite for many years, the day invites visitors to explore a variety of gardens across Laleham. Laleham Village Fair 4th July

Another highlight of the village calendar is the Laleham Village Fair, which will take place on Saturday 4 July 2026 at the Lucan Recreation Ground, from 11.30am to 4.30pm. Planning is already underway for what promises to be another fantastic community event featuring stalls, entertainment and local food vendors. Volunteers are essential to the Fair's success, with help needed for setting up, stewarding and clearing away. No experience is necessary, just a willingness to help. Stall applications are now open through the LRA Events page on the association's website.

Laleham History and Heritage

Laleham's history continues to be celebrated at the Laleham Heritage Centre on The Broadway, between the Recreation Ground and the Village Hall. Run by volunteers, the centre houses documents, photographs and artefacts that tell the story of the village. The centre is open on the first Saturday of each month from 10am to 2pm. Local Infrastructure and Roadworks

The LRA continues to monitor infrastructure issues affecting the village. A dedicated Roadworks page on the association's website provides updates on current and upcoming works in and around Laleham. Recent concerns raised by residents include the planned remodelling of the Staines Road and Broadway roundabout, only months after its construction, which is expected to involve multi-way traffic lights. Residents have also asked when temporary "Ramp" warning signs will be removed and whether recently installed speed humps along Staines Road meet the required specifications. Other issues raised include the absence of a proposed speed table at the Ashford Road entrance to the village, confusing speed limit signage along Ashford Road and enforcement relating to dropped kerbs following resurfacing works. The LRA has written to local councillors and Surrey County Council seeking clarification.
