Laleham Gardens Open Day & Heritage Trail

Saturday 6th June 2026 - 12 noon to 5.00 pm - Tickets £5 available on the day outside the Heritage Centre, The Broadway, Laleham

Returning for the first time since 2019, the Laleham Gardens Open Day has been revived by the LRA with an exciting new addition - a self-guided Heritage Trail celebrating the village's history and character. Visitors will be able to explore a selection of beautiful private gardens, from colourful cottage planting to riverside gems, while also discovering historic buildings, village landmarks and stories from Laleham's past. The new trail transforms the day into a broader celebration of the village itself and promises a relaxed and enjoyable afternoon for residents and visitors alike.

Tickets: Adults £5, children free when accompanied by an adult, including map and guide, are available from 11.45am outside Laleham Heritage Centre, last ticket 4pm; gardens close at 5pm. Proceeds from the event will support village planting and hanging basket funds, helping keep Laleham colourful and welcoming for everyone.
