Fun of the Fair

Looking for a great summer day out? Come along to Laleham Village Fair and enjoy all the attractions of a traditional village fair, including live entertainment, family activities, a Classic Car Show, fun dog show, food, refreshments, and a wide variety of stalls, all in the heart of the village.

There will be music throughout the afternoon, including a traditional brass band and dance displays, alongside stalls offering plants, gifts, local produce and homemade cakes. Visitors can browse community and charity stalls, discover local organisations, and spend time catching up with friends and neighbours.

Younger visitors will find plenty to keep them occupied, with children's races, face painting, glitter tattoos and hair braiding, while the popular Classic Car Show is sure to be a highlight for motoring enthusiasts. A licensed bar and a selection of food outlets will also be available throughout the day.

There will be a grand raffle with a range of prizes, as well as opportunities to support local causes and meet many of the groups that help make village life so vibrant.

With free entry and free on-site parking, the fair offers something for all ages. Whether you come for the entertainment, the classic cars, the community spirit or simply to soak up the atmosphere, Laleham Village Fair is a wonderful way to spend a summer afternoon.

Canine Capers

The main arena of Laleham Village Fair will be the venue of the relaunched dog show. Whether pedigree or mongrel, dogs will have something to offer at this fun show. There will be a variety of classes and entry can be made on the day to any eligible class at £3 (please bring cash).

The show will start with several classes based upon appearance, including: Handsome Boy, Gorgeous Girl, Golden Oldie (over 8 years), Scruffiest/ Fluffiest and Most Like Owner. The judging will not be based upon Crufts standards and the audience can definitely influence decisions!



After those classes have been completed, dogs and their handlers will be invited into the arena to demonstrate their skills. There will be separate sections for handlers aged under and over 14, with a pair judged on both tricks performed and their interaction. There will be classes for: Best trick, Longest stay (in any position), and Most tricks in 1 minute. The handler may 'bribe' the dog (and vice versa) but only the use of visual and verbal commands will be allowed by the judges.

The dog show will run from 1.30 - 3.00pm. But there will be plenty more for canine pets to enjoy with fun dog agility available all afternoon in an adjacent area.
