Local Infrastructure & Roadworks

The LRA continues to monitor local infrastructure issues. A Roadworks page on the LRA website provides updates on current and planned works. Recent concerns include the proposed remodelling of the **Staines Road/Broadway roundabout, temporary "Ramp" signage**, the specification of **new speed humps, missing traffic-calming measures at Ashford Road, unclear speed limits and dropped kerb enforcement**. The LRA is in contact with local councillors and Surrey County Council.
